SAN DIEGO MESA COLLEGE SMOKE-FREE CAMPUS CAMPAIGN

Background: San Diego Mesa College freshman Kendra Jackson is a severe asthmatic and the second-hand smoke at San Diego Mesa College was making her sick. On October 27, 2005, she addressed the San Diego Community College District Board of Trustees, expressing her concerns about second-hand smoke on campus and requested that something be done about it. Following the meeting, she rallied with staff and fellow students to begin a campaign to ban smoking on campus. In December 2005, the Smoking Investigation Committee (SIC) was born. The SIC group hosted a student health fair and gave educational presentations to the campus' shared governance bodies, which voted to ban smoking following a seven-month transition period. On January 1, 2007, the campus became the third community college in the state of California to become smoke-free.

Impact:

- Reduction of unhealthy tobacco smoke on campus.
- Expected reduction in exposure to tobacco smoke to the approximately 22,000 students
- Full accessibility to those who wish to attend school or work on campus who were previously prohibited from doing so because of their severe sensitivity to second-hand smoke.
- Increase in number of persons quitting smoking due to social norm change and healthy habits.
- Increase in healthy lifestyle habits among students.
- Smoking cessation program and increased support to help with addiction.
