This scholarship was established to recognize and provide financial assistance to a deserving student who is a Mathematics student. (One \$250.00 scholarship will be awarded).

TO BE ELIGIBLE STUDENTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

Completion of 2 Mesa Math Courses

- ◆ Current enrollment in at least 8 units at Mesa
- ◆ Current enrollment in Math class at Mesa beyond Math 96
- ◆ Math GPA of at least 3.0
- ◆ Completion of at least 12 units at Mesa College
- ◆ Demonstrated academic success with an overall GPA of at least 3.0
- ◆ You are ineligible if you have received this scholarship in the past.

APPLICATION DEADLINE FEBRUARY 26, 2010

Completed applications and all required supporting documents must be received by 12:00 p.m. on February 26, 2010. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

All completed applications that meet eligibility requirements will be reviewed by a committee composed of Mesa College faculty, classified staff, student government, and administration.

APPLICATIONS WILL BE RATED AS FOLLOWS:

Biographical Questionnaire	30 points maximum
GPA of 3.0 and higher	30 points maximum
Essay	30 points maximum
Recommendation letter (1) from an instructor in the appropriate department	10 points maximum

RECIPIENT NOTIFICATION AND RELEASE OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Recipients will be notified by mid-April. Awards will be presented on Friday May 7, 2010, at the Annual Scholarship Awards Banquet. Recipients will be honored as special guest and will receive one complimentary dinner ticket. Attendance at the Scholarship Banquet is strongly encouraged so that your achievements can be celebrated and the generosity of the donors publicly acknowledged.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Applicants are requested to submit the following documentation:

1. A fully completed application-biographical questionnaire. All information requested must be provided.
2. Submit a current letter of recommendation on official letterhead:
 - One (1) from an instructor in the appropriate department who can provide information regarding personal accomplishments and/or progress in your planned educational program.
3. Submit a well-written original essay about your background, your interest, goals, and accomplishments in Mathematics. The essay should be typed, double spaced, and no longer than two pages.
