ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AND LEADERSHIP AWARD

Associated Students Academic Achievement - Supplement

The Associated Students scholarship fund was established by the San Diego Mesa College Associated Students in the Fall 2000 to recognize and provide financial assistance to and students who have current Associated Students (A.S.) membership and who have excelled academically.

Associated Students (A.S.) officers (elected/appointed) are not eligible to apply.

TO BE ELIGIBLE STUDENTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Be currently enrolled in at least 9 units at Mesa College
- Have completed a minimum of 12 units at Mesa College
- Have a Mesa College/SDCCD grade point average of 3.0 or higher
- Have a declared academic goal: A.A./A.S. Degree, Career Education, or Transfer
- Have an A.S. membership for Spring 2010

While this scholarship is available to both A.S. members and non-members, more scholarships will be awarded to qualified applicants with A.S. membership.

APPLICATION DEADLINE FEBRUARY 26, 2010

Completed applications and all required supporting documents must be received by 12:00 p.m. on February 26, 2010. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

All completed applications that meet eligibility requirements will be reviewed by a committee composed of representatives from the Mesa College faculty, classified staff, student government, administration, and the Mesa College Foundation.

APPLICATIONS WILL BE RATED AS FOLLOWS:

Biographical Questionnaire (neatness, completeness of information provided, presentation)	5 points maximum
GPA of 3.0 and higher	30 points maximum
Academic Course Rigor	10 points maximum
Academic Recognition/Awards	10 points maximum
Essay	35 points maximum
Recommendation letter (1)	10 points maximum

RECIPIENT NOTIFICATION AND AWARDS

Recipients will be notified by mid-April. Awards will be presented on Friday May 7, 2010, at the Annual Scholarship Awards Banquet. Recipients will be honored as special guests and will receive one complimentary dinner ticket. Attendance at the Scholarship Banquet is strongly encouraged so that your achievements can be celebrated and the generosity of the donors publicly acknowledged.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Applicants are requested to submit the following documentation:

1. A fully completed application-biographical questionnaire. All information requested must be provided.
2. Submit a letter of recommendation on official letterhead:
 - One (1) from a Mesa College faculty member (counselors are faculty members) discussing your academic achievement and progress in your planned educational program.
3. Submit a well-written original essay about your academic experiences, and accomplishments at Mesa College, noting your most memorable and/or proudest achievement(s). Your essay should not exceed 500 words or two pages double-spaced.
