**TO BE ELIGIBLE STUDENTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:**

- Be currently enrolled in at least 6 units at Mesa College
- Have completed a minimum of two Biology courses at Mesa College with a minimum grade point average of 3.0
- Have completed a minimum of 12 units at Mesa College
- Have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale for Mesa College courses completed, and cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher

**APPLICATION DEADLINE FEBRUARY 26, 2010**

Completed applications and all required supporting documents must be received by 12:00 p.m. on February 26, 2010. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

**SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA**

All completed applications that meet eligibility requirements will be reviewed by a committee composed of representatives from the Mesa College Biology faculty, classified staff, student government, and administration.

**APPLICATIONS WILL BE RATED AS FOLLOWS:**

Biographical Questionnaire	5 points maximum
GPA of 3.0 and higher – All Mesa classes	10 points maximum
GPA of 3.0 and higher – Mesa Biology classes	20 points maximum
Internships/Community Service	10 points maximum
Essay	30 points maximum
Recommendation letters (2)	10 points maximum
Number of Biology classes completed	15 points maximum

**RECIPIENT NOTIFICATION AND RELEASE OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

Recipients will be notified by mid-April. Awards will be presented on Friday May 7, 2010, at the Annual Scholarship Awards Banquet. Recipients will be honored as special guest and will receive one complimentary dinner ticket. Attendance at the Scholarship Banquet is strongly encouraged so that your achievements can be celebrated and the generosity of the donors publicly acknowledged.

## **APPLICATION CHECKLIST**

*Applicants are requested to submit the following documentation:*

1. A fully completed application-biographical questionnaire. All information requested must be provided.
2. Submit two current letters of recommendation on official letterhead:
  - One (1) from a Mesa College faculty member (counselors are faculty members) specific to this scholarship and discussing your academic achievement and/or progress in your planned educational program.
  - One (1) from a person (non-faculty) who can provide information regarding your internship(s)/work-experience, leadership and/or community service activities.
3. Submit a well-written original essay on the following: Why does the field of biology appeal to you? What events, influences or circumstances in your life have shaped your understanding or appreciation of biology? Please describe these events and your future career or educational goals as they pertain to the field of biology.
