DR. GRANVILLE N. MOORE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - Established Spring 2007

This scholarship was established and funds donated by Professor Judy Sundayo in memory of her father, Dr. Granville N. Moore, a graduate of Meharry Medical School. He provided medical care to the poor of Washington D.C. for over fifty years. This scholarship recognizes one underrepresented student, interested in community service through a career in medicine, dentistry, nursing, physical therapy or pharmacy.

TO BE ELIGIBLE STUDENTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Be currently enrolled in at least 6 semester units at Mesa College
- Have completed a minimum of 24 semester units of college-level coursework
- Have a grade point average of 2.8 or higher
- Have completed an educational plan with a counselor

APPLICATION DEADLINE FEBRUARY 29, 2012

Completed applications and all required supporting documents must be received by 5:00 p.m. on February 29, 2012. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

All completed applications that meet eligibility requirements will be reviewed and rated by Judy Sundayo. The applicant who is rated the highest on the five selection criteria (Application/Biographical Questionnaire, Educational Plan, Community Service Letter, Essay and Letter of Recommendation) will be awarded the scholarship.

APPLICATIONS WILL BE RATED AS FOLLOWS:

Biographical Questionnaire	20 points maximum
Educational Plan	20 points maximum
Community Service Letter	20 points maximum
Essay	20 points maximum
Recommendation letter (1)	20 points maximum

RECIPIENT NOTIFICATION AND RELEASE OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Recipient will be notified by mid-April. Awards will be presented on Friday, April 27, 2012 at the Annual Scholarship Awards Banquet. Recipients will be honored as special guests and will receive one complimentary dinner ticket. Attendance at the Scholarship Banquet is required for release of Scholarship funds. Non-attendance will, in most cases, result in forfeiture of scholarship award.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Applicants are requested to submit the following documentation:

1. _____ A fully completed biographical questionnaire.
2. _____ An official educational plan completed with the assistance of a Mesa College counselor.
3. _____ A letter documenting the completion of a minimum of 20 hours of community service (or internship/work experience that serves a community need) from an agency director, supervisor, manager or work experience coordinator.
4. _____ One letter of recommendation on official letterhead from an instructional faculty person, a counseling faculty person, an employer or supervisor indicating in what capacity they have known you, your personal and/or professional attributes and their opinion of your ability to achieve your educational and professional goals.
5. _____ Submit a well-written original essay about your background, your educational and career goals, and your interest in the field of medicine, dentistry, physical therapy, or pharmacy. Please speak to how community service will figure into your future goals. The essay must be typed, double-spaced and limited to two pages (maximum length).
6. _____ Submit **unofficial** transcripts
