This scholarship fund was established by San Diego Community College District who has been accepted into a health-related program.

TO BE ELIGIBLE STUDENTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Must have an interest in pursuing a career in a health-related field such as: nursing, radiologic technology, dental assisting or emergency medical technology.
- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Must have demonstrated financial need. Verification of financial need will be processed through the Financial Aid Office at Mesa College.

APPLICATION DEADLINE FEBRUARY 29, 2012

Completed applications and all required supporting documents must be received by **5:00 pm on February 29th, 2012**. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

All completed applications that meet eligibility requirements will be reviewed by a committee comprised of representatives from Mesa College.

APPLICATIONS WILL BE RATED AS FOLLOWS:

Grade Point Average	20 points maximum
Essay	50 points maximum
Leadership/Community Service	10 points maximum
Financial Need	20 points maximum

RECIPIENT NOTIFICATION AND RELEASE OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Recipients will be notified by mid-April. Awards will be presented on Friday April 27 2012, at the annual Scholarship Awards Banquet. Recipients will be honored as special guests and will receive one complimentary dinner ticket. Attendance at the Scholarship Banquet is strongly encouraged so that your achievements can be celebrated and the generosity of the donors publicly acknowledged.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Applicants are requested to submit the following documentation:

1. Submit a fully completed biographical questionnaire. All information requested must be provided.
2. Submit **unofficial** transcripts.
3. Submit one current letter of recommendation on official letterhead:
 - From a person who can verify your participation in health-related field (i.e., clinical supervisor or a faculty member in a health service program).
4. Submit a well-written original essay discussing your interest in pursuing a career in the health field and indicating your financial need. Your essay should not exceed 500 words.
