This program provides students, and especially veterans, with skills to find employment in a wide variety of fields such as chemical dependency treatment, youth work, community corrections, developmental disabilities, case management, and older adult programs, working with the mentally ill and child welfare. The required fieldwork portion of this program provides excellent opportunities for finding employment through networking with other professionals.

In fact, networking, career exploration, job coaching and placement assistance are a key part of the services offered.
