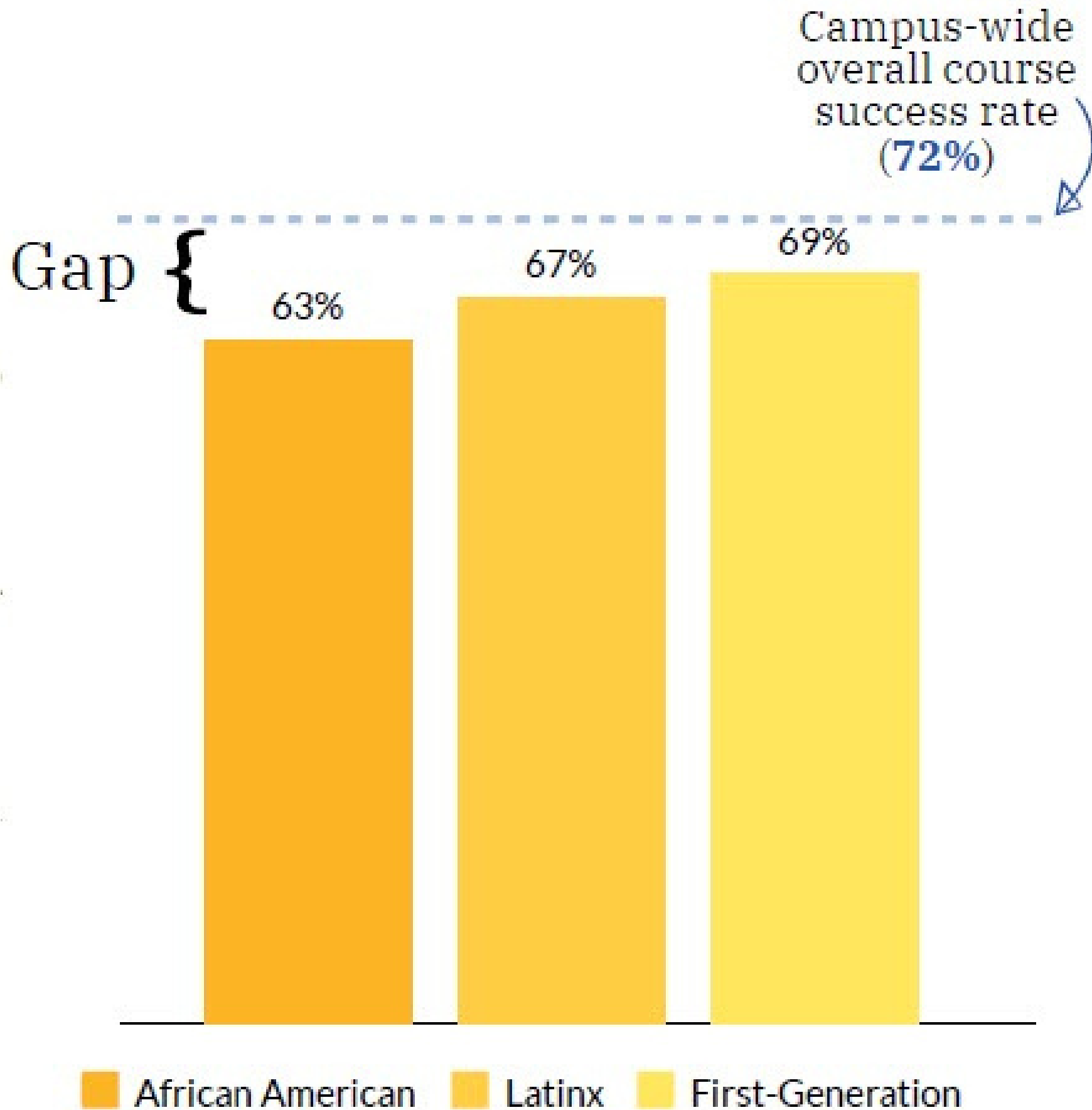

Combined Course Success Rate in Fall 2017, Fall 2018, and Fall 2019



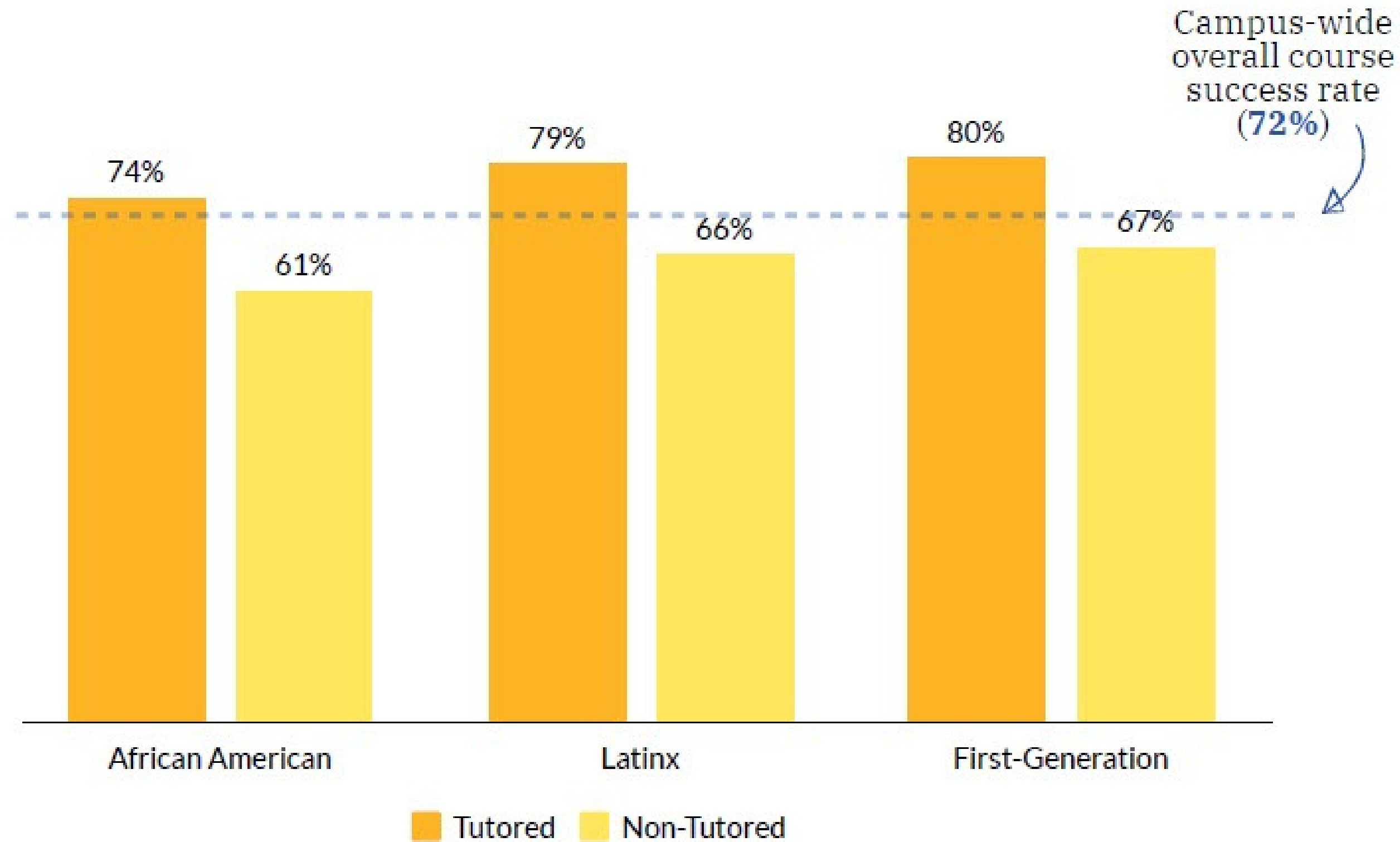
Equity Gap
